IMPORTANT EU Exam Details and Tips- please give to veterinarian

Dr. Hungerbuehler will evaluate the EU test. He states the follow, "I need color Doppler examination of the ureteral jet in long and short axis. I need measurement of the beginning of the ureteral jet to the vesicourethral point. If we see two ureterjets in the bladder using color Doppler or b-flow we are sure, that everything is all right. 15 mm are considered optimal."

Additional notes from successful tests done in the U.S.

- 1. A diuretic is used to increase the flow of urine to the bladder, e.g. lasix , furosemide.
- 2. Examining area of the belly is shaved.
- 3. Anesthesia is used to insure stillness of the dog.
- 4. IV fluids can be administered to insure urine flow to the bladder.
