Instructions on the examination for ectopic ureters

- Last feeding in the evening or not within the last 6 hours before the procedure, free access to water. Avoid urination before the examination. A well-filled bladder is a prerequisite for a sonographic examination.
- You can find the current "Findings Sheet for Assessment of the Ureters" at www.klm-gna.org under Breeding Forms. To ensure that the appraisal can be sent back to you as quickly as possible, please complete the upper part of the Findings Sheet completely and legibly.
- For the examination appointment at a veterinary practice of your choice, you must take the Findings Sheet with you. The veterinarian will complete the lower portion of the exam, including measurements.
- Email the completed Findings Sheet to the Breed Warden, Ross Siemers, at rfsiemers281@comcast.net.
- Have the veterinarian send the ultrasound files via Dropbox to the Breed Warden at rfsiemers281@comcast.net.
- The Breed Warden will assure that the files are sent properly to Germany.
- Results of the appraisal usually take about least 6 weeks.
- As part of the X-ray examination for HD or the sonographic examination of the ureters, a blood sample must be taken by the veterinarian for each dog (see the form of blood storage on the homepage of the KIM Verband www.kleine-muensterlaender.org under "Forms")
