Requirements for admission:

- All dogs from the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer e.V. with an FCI pedigree and a passed VJP are eligible for the Lönssuche.
- All handlers residing in the Federal Republic of Germany must present a hunting license valid in Germany. Handlers from the USA must present a valid hunting license from a US state.
- A valid rabies vaccination, confirmed by a veterinarian and entered in the vaccination passport, must be presented for each dog on the day of arrival. Dogs without this certificate will be excluded.
- Only dogs that have not been found to have any breed-eliminating faults before the closing date for entries will be admitted. This includes any faults of temperament that have been identified and which preclude breeding.

Testing conditions

- The test will be conducted in accordance with the current Test Regulations and General Guidelines for the Lönssuche of the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer e. V..
- The organizer will provide shotguns and ammunition to test gun stability in the field and at the water. All shots required during the test will be fired by a person appointed by the organizer.
- Live ducks, drag game (fur and feathered game) will be provided by the organizer, as well as a dead duck to determine gun stability at the water.

- The pointing and field work will be carried out on different types of game birds.
- For the subject retrieving feathered game, a feathered game bird will be dispatched in such a way that the dog must retrieve the feathered game without having seen the game fall in the cover.
- Free-running dogs are not permitted. During the test, dogs must be kept on a leash until otherwise instructed by a Judge.
- Handlers of bitches in heat must inform the Test Director before the start of the test.
- Please respect the property and do not leave any litter!

Verbandsrichter:

- Each Landesgruppe must provide a Judge or pay the costs for a Judge from the USA in the amount of Euro 400.
- Association Judges must be in possession of a valid hunting license and be registered as an active Judge on the current JGHV list.
- If a Landesgruppe is able and willing to provide more judges, this is possible and desirable in consultation with the Test Director.

Entries:

- The Judges should be registered by 01.08.2024.
- Formblatt 1 (status 2019-1) with a handwritten, legible signature of the registrant and a copy of the current pedigree must be submitted, preferably as a scanned version in PDF format by e-mail.
- Entries must be submitted solely via the respective Landesgruppen.

Evaluation: The evaluation of the Breed Show is carried out according to the currently valid Breed Show Regulations of the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer e.V.

Class divisions: The closing date is the day before the Breed Show.

- Junior class: Dogs that are 6 months but not yet 9 months old.
- Youth class: dogs that are 9 months but not yet 15 months old.
- Utility class: Dogs 15 months and older with a passed HZP or VGP/VPS.
- Open class: Dogs 15 months and older, without a passed HZP or VGP/VPS.

Requirements for admission:

The Breed Show is open to all KIM registered in the breed book of the Verband für Kleine Münsterländer e.V. or in a foreign breed book recognized by the F.C.I..

Proof of a valid rabies vaccination must be presented for each dog.
